AWARD OF LOK ADALAT BENCH NO.4

On the last date of hearing following order was passed:-

“Discussed.

Learned counsel for the appellant states that if an amount of Rs.7,60,000/- is paid to the appellant over and above, the amount already awarded by MACT, issue involved in this matter can be settled. The proposal sheet has been signed by the learned counsel for the appellant.

Learned counsel for the Insurance Company seeks an adjournment to get Instructions.

On his request, adjourned to 30.05.2024.

A copy of this order be supplied to the counsel for the Insurance company. ”

Mr. Bhupander Ghanghas, Advocate for the appellant signed the consent proposal on 23.05.2024, showing willingness to accept an amount of Rs.7,60,000/-(Rupees Seven Lakhs Sixty Thousand Only) towards full and final settlement of the claim in the present appeal.

Mr. R.C. Kapoor, Advocate and representatives for respondent No.4-

Insurance Company have also signed the said statement today, accepting the

proposal made by the counsel for the appellant.

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As per the statement of learned counsel for the appellant, the enhanced amount will be paid to the appellant-Sonu.

Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit cheque for Rs.7,60,000/- (Rupees Seven Lakhs Sixty Thousand Only) favouring appellant-Sonu s/o Sh. Ranbir Singh with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court on or before 29.07.2024. Failing compliance of the order, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of this order. The appellant's counsel may collect the cheque from the office of the Lok Adalat after retaining the photocopy of the cheque/draft bearing signatures of the Counsel.

Appeal stands disposed of.
