AMARJOT BHATTI, J.

1. Petitioner – Gurpash Singh has filed criminal writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus for directing official respondents No.1 to 3 to decide his representation dated 05.08.2024 (Annexure P-1) and to protect his life and liberty from the hands of private respondents No.4 to 7.

2. Notice of motion.

3. On asking of this Court, Mr. Kewal Singh, Addl. A.G., Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the State. He confirmed that he has already received complete copy of petition along with representation and hence stated that said representation will be disposed of within a period of two weeks.

4. Considering the nature of litigation no purpose would be served by serving notice to private respondents.

5. In view of above, present petition is accordingly disposed of with direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to decide representation dated



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05.08.2024 (Annexure P-1) within a period of two weeks from the receipt of copy of this order and in the meantime, life and liberty of petitioner be protected considering threat perception.

6. Petition is accordingly disposed of.

7. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, stand disposed of accordingly as well.
