Learned counsel for the petitioners submit that the respondents are liable to be directed to grant the petitioners the benefit of the daily wage service rendered by them prior to the regularisation of their services as well

as grant of pensionary benefits under the Old Pension Scheme keeping in view the judgment in *Harbans Lal's case (supra)*.

Mr. Amarpreet Singh Bains, AAG Punjab, appears and accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

Learned State counsel submits that in case the representation (Annexure P-5) dated 18.05.2024 has been received in the concerned office, an appropriate order on the same would be passed by respondents within a period of 8 weeks of the receipt of copy of this order. Learned State counsel further submits that in case, it is found feasible to accept the claim of the petitioners, the same will be accepted, otherwise due reasons will be mentioned for not accepting the claim of the petitioners in the speaking order to be passed, which will be conveyed to them.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submit that keeping in view the statement of the learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed of as having been not pressed any further.

Ordered accordingly.
