KIRTI SINGH, J.(Oral)

1. Apprehending arrest in FIR No.0189 dated 09.06.2024, under Sections 341, 323, 324, 427, 307, 34 IPC registered at Police Station Sohana, District SAS Nagar, Punjab, the petitioner has preferred this petition under Section 482 BNSS, 2023 for grant of anticipatory bail.

2. Succinct factual narrative relevant for the disposal of the instant petition is that the aforementioned FIR was registered on the basis of the statement of the complainant namely Nazar Singh, in which he broadly stated that on 08.06.2024, when he was going towards the field from his house along with his son Gursimran Singh, then his elder son Lovepreet Singh-petitioner came in his car, Endeavour bearing no. PB-65-H-3588 and hit his younger son namely Gursimran Singh with his car and then hit the complainant who was standing in the

Set with an intention of killing him and they were admitted in hospital. He

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further stated that on 21.05.2024 also the petitioner alongwith three-four other persons attacked the complainant with deadly weapons.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner *inter alia* submits that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case. He further submits that the complainant is the one who used to threaten and do wrongful acts within an intent of causing harm to the present petitioner. He further submits that the complainant suddenly came in front of the car which was being driven by the petitioner and the complainant even damaged the car by throwing bricks on it.

4. Learned State counsel submits that the investigation has been initiated and CCTV footages were analyzed wherein the petitioner could be seen running over his car on the complainant. The statements of witnesses under section 161 Cr.P.C. were recorded. He further submits that the medico-legal reports of the complainant Nazar Singh and his younger son Gursimran Singh dated 08.06.2024, were also obtained from the concerned doctor. As per the MLP, the complainant received 6 injuries, out of which 5 injuries are being kept under ortho and surgery opinion by the concerned Doctor. As per the MLR of the injured Gursimran Singh, he received total 2 injuries and both the injuries are being kept for ortho opinion. In the earlier incident of 31.05.2024, the MLR of the complainant shows that the complainant had received 2 injuries, one of which was an incised wound by sharp weapon.

5. That apart from the present FIR, the petitioner is involved in other cases/FIRs, the detail of which is as follows: -

i. FIR No. 66 dated 16.03.2016, under Sections 307,323,506,34 IPC at Police Station Sohana, District SAS Nagar, Punjab.

ii. FIR No. 282 dated 30.08.2019, under Sections 294, 324,452,506,34 IPC at Police Station Sohana, District SAS Nagar, Punjab.



iii. FIR No. 145 dated 04.05.2023, under Sections 148,149, 323,341,506 IPC, 452 IPC (added later on) at Police Station Singh Saran Regn. No.11547 Sohana, District SAS Nagar, Punjab. S.A.S. Nagar (Mohali).

iv. FIR No. 120 dated 18.10.2024, under Sections 353,186 IPC, at Police Station Sohana, District SAS Nagar, Punjab.

V. FIR No. 16/2023, under Section 279,427,337,338 IPC at Police Station Sohana, District SAS Nagar, Punjab.

6. Heard the rival submissions made by learned counsel for the parties and perused the record.
7. There are serious allegations leveled against the petitioner and to unearth the true dimension of the alleged crime, this Court does not deem it appropriate to interfere in the matter so as to grant the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner at this stage.
8. The petition is dismissed.
