1. This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 10 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, for punishing the respondents for disobeying the order dated 23.11.2021 and dated 02.03.2022 passed by the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Ludhiana, in complaint No.COMA-15372-2021.
2. Perusal of the file shows that the orders qua which the contempt is claimed, were passed by the Court of Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Ludhiana. The said Court is having enough power to enforce its own orders. Therefore, this Court does not find any ground to continue with the present petition any more.
3. Dismissed.
4. However, the petitioner would be at liberty to avail any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
