The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 438 of Cr.P.C with a prayer to grant anticipatory bail to him in case FIR No.734, dated 23.10.2023, under Sections 10,24 of Immigration Act and 120-B, 406,420 of IPC, registered at Police Station Shahabad, District Kurukshetra (Annexure P-1).
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the matter has been amicably resolved between the parties and in compliance of the order dated 28.08.2024 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.
3. Learned State counsel also submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for further investigation.
4. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of complainant submits that

the parties have amicably resolved all their disputes and the complainant has received the amount in pursuance of the compromise between the parties.

4. In view of the above statement made by learned counsel for the parties, the interim order dated 28.08.2024 is made absolute. The petitioner shall continue to join the investigation, as and when called by the Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 482 (2) of B.N.S.S/438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
