Main case

Present petition has been filed under Section 482 of Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for quashing cross case vide DDR No.32 dated 09.09.2016 registered under Sections 452, 324, 323 & 506 read with Section 34

IPC in FIR No. 70 dated 09.09.2016 registered under Sections 452, 324, 323 & 506 read with Section 34 IPC at Police Station, Kheri Gandian, District Patiala along with all consequential proceedings on the basis of compromise (P-3).

2. Concededly, petitioners were convicted and sentenced by learned Judicial Magistrate First Class, Rajpura vide judgment of conviction and order of sentence dated 11.04.2023 and an appeal thereagainst is stated to be pending before the Court of Additional Sessions Judge, Patiala.

3. In view of the above, this Court is not inclined to entertain the present petition.

4. Disposed off accordingly with liberty to the petitioners to raise their grievance before learned appellate Court.

5. Needless to say that there would be no harm, in case the compromise, if any, entered into between the parties is considered as per law while deciding the appeal.
