1. The learned counsel for the petitioners seeks leave to withdraw the writ petition.
2. Leave granted.
3. Consequently, the extant writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn. However liberty reserved to the petitioners to challenge the orders for cancellation of lease deed, through theirs making an appeal thereagainst before the authority contemplated under Section 10-A of the Punjab Village Common Lands (Regulation) Act, 1961.
4. In case, the said appeal is time barred, thereupon with the said appeal, an application under Section 14 of the Limitation Act, becoming

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appended thus, therewith, thus thereons lawful order shall be passed, and, subsequently the said appeal is directed to be decided on merits, but after hearing all affected persons concerned. In addition, the said statutory appeal shall be decided within four months from its preferment.
