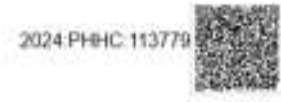

HARSH BUNGER J. (ORAL)

1. Prayer in the instant civil writ petition filed under Article 226 of Constitution of India is for issuance of a writ in the nature of *mandamus*, directing respondents No.1 to 3 to decide the representations dated 25.01.2023, 23.10.2023 and 11.03.2024 (Annexures P-8 to P-10) submitted by petitioner and to make necessary changes in the revenue records as well as Gardawari/Jamabandi-Fard, in view of Civil Court judgments and decrees.
2. After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks withdrawal of the instant petition with liberty to the petitioner to avail her other remedies available under the law.



- 3. Keeping in view the aforesaid submission made by learned counsel for the petitioners, the present writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty aforesaid.
