1. Prayer in the instant civil writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of Constitution of India is for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the official respondents to take action against respondents No. 5 and 6 as well as to recover honorarium amount received by respondent No. 5 wrongly and illegally from the Government treasury.

2. After arguing for some time, learned counsel for petitioner seeks withdrawal of the instant civil writ petition with liberty to approach the Deputy Commissioner concerned as regards the grievance as raised in this petition.
