The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 with a prayer to grant anticipatory bail to him in case FIR No.39 dated 01.08.2024, registered under Sections 115(2), 118, 3(5) and 118(2) of BNS, 2023 (old Sections 323, 326, 37 of IPC), at Police Station Behrampur, District Gurdaspur.
