1. The present Civil Revision Petition has been filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India for setting aside the impugned order dated 19.07.2023 (Annexure P-10) passed by the Civil Judge (Jr. Divn.), Malerkotla whereby the execution application bearing No.204 of 2018 filed by the Decree Holder/respondent No.1 under Order 21 Rule 32 CPC has been allowed.

2. It has been brought to the notice of this Court that vide order dated 29.02.2024, the execution proceedings are stated to have been satisfied and have been withdrawn and JD Avtar Singh, who had been arrested, has been ordered to be released from the custody and thus, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.

3. In view of the above, present Civil Revision Petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.

4. Liberty is granted to the petitioners to revive the petition, in case any cause of action survives.
