HARKESH MANUJA, J.(ORAL)

1. By way of present petition filed under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India, prayer has been made for initiating contempt proceedings against the respondents for willful non-compliance of the order dated 15.01.2024 passed by this Court in CWP-2616-2016 wherein, respondents have been directed to re-consider the case of petitioner subject to availability of post and his physical fitness.

2. Learned counsel for the respondent/UOI submits that the order dated 15.01.2024 has been complied with by passing a speaking order dated 23.09.2024 wherein the claim of the petitioner has been rejected as he was found unfit in his physical fitness.

3. In view of the aforesaid, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the present petition with liberty to challenge the same in accordance with law.

4. Dismissed as not pressed with aforesaid liberty.
