The prayer in the petition under Section 438 Cr.PC is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.260 dated 02.07.2023 registered under Sections 323, 34, 341, 427 IPC (Section 307, 325 IPC added later on) registered at P.S. Hansi Sadar.

Learned Counsel for the petitioners submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 20.10.2023 passed by this Court, petitioners have joined the investigation.

The learned State Counsel on instructions submits that the petitioners have joined investigation in terms of orders dated 20.10.2023 and are not required for custodial interrogation.

In this view of the matter, interim order dated 20.10.2023 is made absolute.

However, the petitioners shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and they shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
