Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.147 dated 28.07.2023, under Sections 120-B, 420, 467, 468 & 471 of IPC at Police Station Bajghera, District Gurugram.

Vide order dated 21.09.2023, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that vide order dated 02.04.2024, matter was referred to Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court, however, respondent/complainant did not appear before the Mediation Centre. Report of the Mediator is placed on record, which would show that petitioner No.1 was present, however, due to absence of respondent/complainant, mediation could not take place. She further submits that in pursuance to the order dated 21.09.2023, petitioner has joined the investigation and as such his interim bail may be made absolute.



Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Chunni Lal, affirmed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, interim order dated 21.09.2023 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands allowed.
