1. The present writ petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of *certiorari* for quashing the impugned order dated 15.09.2022 (Annexure P-5) qua the petitioner only vide which he has been transferred from District Kurukshetra to Panchkula just because he brought to the notice of higher authorities and the police about the illegal activities of stealing/misappropriation department's goods/material by his co-workers.
