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1. By this common order, three writ petitions, the details of which have been given in the heading, are being disposed of as all these petitions involve the same question of law on similar facts.

2. In the present writ petitions, the grievance being raised by the petitioner(s) is that the petitioner(s) were appointed as a Guest Faculty in Mechanical Engineering Department in the respondent-University and they have been relieved from service by stating that the workload of the post on which the petitioner(s) were working, has decreased and the same has been given to a regular employee whereas, the petitioners' services can be utilized in any other Department keeping in view the expertise of the petitioner(s) which option has not been explored before relieving the petitioner(s) from service.

3. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondent-University submits that in case any representation is received at the hands of the petitioner(s) claiming that they can be accommodated at any other post, the same will be considered and appropriate speaking order on the said representation will be passed within a period of eight weeks of the receipt of any such claim/representation and in case it is found that the petitioner(s) are entitled for any relief, the same will be granted to them otherwise due reasons will be mentioned in the speaking order to be passed for not accepting the claim of the petitioner(s), which reasons will be conveyed to the petitioner(s) for their information and necessary action.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner(s) submits that keeping in view the statement of learned counsel for the respondent-University, the



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present writ petitions may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.

5. Ordered accordingly.

6. Civil miscellaneous application pending if any, also stands disposed of.
