Present petition has been filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. praying for quashing of impugned order dated 02.03.2023 (P-4), passed by learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Jalandhar, vide which application dated 05.12.2022 (P-2) for compounding the offence filed by the petitioner in Complaint Case NACT/3462-2021 dated 13.09.2021, under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881 was dismissed.
