1. The present Civil Revision Petition has been filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India for setting aside the order dated 02.08.2022 (Annexure P-5) passed by the Additional District Judge, Ferozepur vide which the appeal filed by the petitioner/plaintiff has been dismissed as well as the order dated 05.05.2022 (Annexure P-4) passed by the Civil Judge (Jr. Divn.), Ferozepur vide which the application filed by the petitioner/plaintiff has been dismissed.
