1. The counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner performed marriage with respondent No.10 Nisha Sharma on 28.03.2021. Thereafter, dispute arose between them and respondent No.10 left the company of petitioner. It is further submitted that petitioner is not responsible for the aforesaid matrimonial dispute in any manner. It is further submitted that there is apprehension that the petitioner will be falsely implicated some criminal case at the instance of respondent No.10. That certain police officials including respondent No.5 are also helping respondent No.10. In this regard, petitioner has already submitted application/representation (Annexure P-3) to respondent No.2. It is further submitted that petitioner is being unnecessarily harassed by the local police of Ludhiana at the instance of respondent No.10.

2. Notice of motion.

3. Mr. J.S. Dhaliwal, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of



the State and submits that one application given by respondent No.10 is also pending with the police at Ludhiana. That police is looking into the matter. It is further submitted that in case any such representation filed by petitioner is pending, the same will be disposed of by the competent authority in accordance with law.

4. In light of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of and in case any complaint/application filed by the opposite party is pending before the police, the police should proceed further in the said matter in accordance with law and not to unnecessarily harass the petitioner. Direction is also given to respondent No.2 to consider and decide representation (Annexure P-3) filed by the petitioner as per law within a period of 4 weeks of the receipt of copy of this order. The petitioner is also directed to appear before respondent No.2 within period of next two weeks to plead his grievances.
