The petition has been filed, *inter alia*, seeking a writ of *certiorari* seeking quashing of order dated 19.08.2019, Annexure P-4; further writ of *mandamus* directing the respondents to revise and grant salary to the petitioner as per seventh pay Commission, and AICTE Regulation, 2010.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that grievance raised herein is pending for appropriate decision before the respondents. At this stage, the petitioner will be satisfied in case fifth respondent is directed to decide his pending legal notice, dated 16.03.2024, Annexure P-11, in a specified period.
