The prayer in the present petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C.
is for the grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.72 dated 19.03.2023
under Sections 279, 336, 420, 427 IPC & Section 15(c), 17 of the NDPS
Act registered at Police Station Civil Lines, Jind.

2. On 01.09.2023, the following order was passed:-
