HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI J. (ORAL)

1. Learned counsel for the petitioner is claiming that as all the posts of Dental Surgeon as advertised vide Advertisement dated 02.05.2017 could not be filled up, the petitioner who had competed for the post in question, though was not selected in the final result, be considered for appointment against the said vacant post.
2. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that there was no waiting list which was prepared for the post in question and the question of law that once, there was no waiting list, even if the post remained vacant, no such claim can be raised by the candidate who had competed for the post, has already been decided while passing order in *CWP No.16518 of 2017 titled as Krishan Kumar vs. State of Haryana and others, decided on*

22.07.2022 and the decision rendered in *Krishan Kumar’s case (supra)* covers the claim of the petitioner.

- 3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has not been able to rebut the said fact.
- 4. Keeping in view the above, the present writ petition is also dismissed in terms of the order passed in *Krishan Kumar’s case (supra)*.
