The present petition has been filed challenging the order dated 15.03.2024 (Annexure P-25) passed by the Learned Education Tribunal for the grant of certain benefits in favour of respondent No. 1.

On being asked to point out any infirmity in the order of the Tribunal by which certain benefits have been granted to the respondent No. 1, learned counsel for the petitioners has not been able to point out any such infirmity so as to be taken into account for addressing the grievance being raised by the petitioners in the present petition. The only ground taken to deny the benefit to respondent No. 1 is the financial difficulty.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioners and have gone through the record with his able assistance.



Once, no infirmity in the impugned order passed by the Educational Tribunal has been pointed out to this Court, no occasion arises for any interference by this Court.

With regard to the financial difficulty being pleaded, the same cannot be allowed in favour of the petitioners so as to deny the legitimate benefits to the respondent-employee keeping in view the actual service rendered which have been granted by the Tribunal keeping in view the statute governing the petitioner-Institute. The financial difficulty cannot be made a ground to deny the legitimate benefits accruing to an employee.

No ground is made out for any interference by this Court in the present petition.
