1. Petitioner-Parag Wadhera has filed present petition under Section 528 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 for issuance of appropriate directions to respondents no.2 and 3 to expeditiously decide the complaint (Annexure P-9) pending before respondent no.3 against respondent no.4.

2. Learned counsel for petitioner argued that the petitioner married respondent no.4 who ran away with one Nirmal Lamba alongwith all the jewellery and other articles gifted by the petitioner. The petitioner has been duped and cheated. He has filed complaint (Annexure P-9) against respondent no.4 which is pending before respondent no.3.

3. Notice of motion to respondents no.1 to 3 only at this stage.

4. On the asking of this Court, Mr. Kewal Singh, Addl.

A.G.Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents no.1 to 3. Advance copy

of petition has already been supplied to learned State counsel alongwith aforesaid complaint. It is stated that the said complaint (Annexure P-9) will be disposed of by respondent no.3 within one month.

5. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, present petition is disposed of with direction to respondent no.3 to dispose of complaint (Annexure P-9) filed by petitioner, within a period of one month from the date of receipt of copy of this order.

6. The petition is accordingly disposed of.
