KULDEEP TIWARI, J.(Oral)

1. Through the instant petition, the petitioners seek issuance of mandamus upon the official respondents no.1 to 4, get FIR No.261, dated 21.05.2023, under Sections 302, 147, 149, 323, 452 and 506 IPC, registered at Police Station Rania, District Sirsa, registered against the accused, investigate from an officer of a superior rank, as compared to the rank of SHO concerned, as he is not making any endeavours to arrest the accused persons, and not conducting the investigation in fair and impartial manner.

2. This Court vide order dated 21.08.2024, directed the State to file a status report regarding the instant FIR.

3. In pursuance of the aforesaid order, a status report by way of an affidavit of Ajaib Singh, DSP, Ellenabad, has been filed. A study survey of the status report (*supra*), it reflects that the total 14 persons

were found to be involved in the instant occurrence, whereas, accused-Varinder, Pawan Kumar and Chhinda, were declared innocent.

4. Learned State counsel, on instructions imparted to him by the police official concerned, informs this Court that a Special Investigating Team (SIT), has been constituted to conduct the investigation, and only four persons remaining to be arrested. Out of them, anticipatory bail petition of one accused-Dula Ram, has been declined by this court vide order even date in CRM-M-63830-2024.

5. This Court has considered the stage of the investigation, and is of the view that no direction is required to be passed, at this stage, in the instant matter. Therefore, the instant petition is, hereby, ordered to be **closed**.

6. In case the grievances of the petitioner still survives, he has liberty to approach the learned magistrate concerned, under the apt provisions of law.

7. **Disposed of** accordingly.

8. All pending applications, if any, also stand **disposed** of accordingly.
