Prayer in the instant petition filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 and 3, to protect the life of the petitioner at the hands of respondents No.7 and 8 and to take action on the representation/complaint dated 12.08.2024 (Annexure P-1).

2. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner restricts her prayer for issuance of directions to respondent No.3-Senior Superintendent of Police, S.B.S. Nagar, to look into the complaint dated 12.08.2024 (Annexure P-1) of the petitioner and take appropriate steps in accordance with law.

4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Amit Rana, Senior Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the State.

5. In view of the restricted prayer of the learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of with directions to respondent No.3-Senior Superintendent of Police, S.B.S. Nagar, to look into the complaint dated 12.08.2024 (Annexure P-1) of the petitioner

and take appropriate steps, if required, as expeditiously as possible, in accordance with law.
