1. By way of present petition filed under Sections 10 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, prayer has been made for initiating contempt proceedings against the respondents for willful non-compliance of the order dated 19.01.2024 passed by this Court in CWP-23496-2016.

2. Learned State counsel submits that petitioner has already been granted benefit of notional promotion for the post of Deputy Director w.e.f. 27.08.2015 i.e. from the date when his juniors were promoted and he further informs that refixation of retiral benefits along with disbursement thereof, shall be made within a period of two weeks from today.

3. In view of the aforesaid undertaking, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the present petition at this stage and submits that the same be disposed of with liberty to revive the same in case needful is not done.

4. Ordered accordingly.

5. However, in case the needful is not done within the

aforementioned period, as per the undertaking, the petitioner would be at liberty to seek revival of the contempt petition and in that eventuality, the respondents would be liable to pay additional sum of Rs.50,000/- as costs from his own pocket in favour of the petitioner towards litigation expenses, immediately, i.e. on the first date of listing of revival application.

6. Rule stands discharged.
