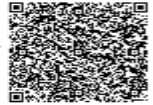

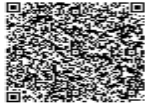

1. This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 11 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, for punishing the respondents for disobeying the order dated 22.03.2023 passed in LPA-316-2023.
2. Affidavit of Jitender Kumar, Director, Secondary Education, Haryana, Panchkula, filed in the Registry, is taken on record.
3. Counsel for the respondents submits that the order dated 22.03.2023 passed in LPA-316-2023 has since been complied with and the representation filed by the petitioner has been decided by passing a speaking order dated 25.01.2024 (Annexure R-1).
4. Counsel for the petitioner has not even disputed the aforesaid fact.
5. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered

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infructuous and dismissed, as such.

6. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left un-redressed, she would be at liberty to raise the same in any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
