1. By way of present petition, prayer has been made for initiation of contempt proceedings against the respondent on account of alleged willful non-compliance of order dated 22.04.2022 passed by this Court in CWP-19461-2020.

2. Learned counsel for the respondent informs that the PPO No.61932/s/Pb has been issued in favour of the petitioner on 01.10.2024. Thus, learned State counsel, Mr. Athar Ahmed, Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, is requested to intimate this fact to the concerned official of the Administrative Department i.e. the Deputy Commissioner, SBS Nagar for necessary release of the family pension along with arrears, within a period of three weeks.

3. In view of the above, no further orders are required to be passed

in the present petition, as such, the same is disposed of. Rule stands discharged.

4. However, in case the needful is not done within the aforementioned period, the petitioner would be at liberty to seek revival of contempt petition and in that eventuality, the erring/concerned officer would be liable to pay a sum of Rs.50,000/- as costs from his/her own pocket in favour of the petitioners towards litigation expenses, immediately, i.e. on the first date of listing of revival application.
