KULDEEP TIWARI. J.(Oral)

1. Through the instant petition, as instituted under Section 482 of the BNSS, 2023, the petitioner has sought the concession of his being enlarged on anticipatory bail, in case FIR No.0201 dated 24.07.2023, under Sections 21/29/61/85 of the NDPS Act, registered at Police Station City Kapurthala, District Kapurthala.
2. After addressing arguments for some time, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks leave to withdraw the instant petition, however, with liberty to the petitioner to surrender before the learned trial Court concerned, and to make an application for bail before the latter concerned, which may be directed to be decided most expeditiously.
3. Leave granted.
4. Consequently, the instant petition is **dismissed** as withdrawn, however, with liberty to the petitioner, to surrender before the learned trial Court concerned, within 10 days from today, and thereupon, if the petitioner makes an

application before the learned trial Court concerned, for grant of bail, the latter shall decide the same within three days, after affording adequate opportunity of hearing to the parties concerned.
