Present petition has been filed for issuance of appropriate directions to respondents No.1 to 3 to handover the investigation of the case FIR No.103 dated 13.08.2024, registered under Sections 21(c), 25 and 29 of the NDPS Act Act, at Police Station Dugri, District Ludhiana to any other independent Investigating Agency or to any Police official of the highest rank as the petitioner does not expect a fair, impartial and expeditious investigation into the above noted case because firstly, the Police of CIA Staff Ludhiana has falsely implicated the son of the petitioner namely Deepak Garg and thereafter, falsely nominated the petitioner as an accused for certain malafide and extraneous considerations. Further prayer has been made to direct the official respondents, not to take any coercive steps against the petitioner or her family members and not to harass them unnecessarily as the Police of Crime Branch or CIA Staff Ludhiana had ransacked the residential house of the petitioner time and again and had also illegally taken away jewellery and cash.



Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that for the redressal of her grievance, a representation dated 17.08.2024 (Annexure P-10) has been filed before the Director General of Police, Punjab Police Head Quarters, Chandigarh but the same has not been taken into consideration till date. He has further submitted that the petitioner would be satisfied if representation dated 17.08.2024 (Annexure P-10) is decided in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Tarun Aggarwal, Sr. D.A.G., Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-State.

Heard.

After hearing counsel for the parties, respondent No.2- the Director General of Police, Punjab, Punjab Police Headquarters, Sector-9, Chandigarh, is directed to decide the representation dated 17.08.2024 (Annexure P-10) expeditiously preferably within one month from today, in accordance with law.

In view of the above, present petition is disposed of.
