1. This petition has been filed under Section 482 of Bharatiya Nagrik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (earlier Section 438 of Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973) for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.217, dated 09.11.2022, registered under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B of IPC at Police Station Salem Tabri, District Police Commissionerate, Ludhiana.

2. Pursuant to order dated 30.08.2024, status report by way of affidavit dated 04.09.2024 of Murad Jasvir Singh Gill, PPS, Assistant Commissioner of Police PBI, Economic Offence and Cyber Crime, Ludhiana, on behalf of respondent-State, has been filed in Court today, which is taken on record. A perusal of said report reveals that vide order

dated 31.08.2024 passed by learned trial Court, petitioner has been declared proclaimed person.

3. Faced with the situation that the petitioner has been declared proclaimed offender, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that present petition has become infructuous and he seeks withdrawal of the same and to avail appropriate remedy.

4. Allowed, as prayed for.

5. Dismissed as withdrawn as having rendered infructuous.
