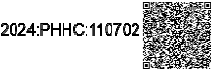

TRIBHUVAN DAHIYA, J. (Oral)

This petition has been filed, *inter alia*, seeking a writ of *certiorari* quashing the order dated 22.08.2024, Annexure P-9, whereby the petitioner, who has been working as Principal, has been transferred from Government College, Faridabad to Government College, Tigaon, District Faridabad, against the third respondent, who has been posted in her place.

2. Learned counsel contends that the petitioner was transferred to Government College, Faridabad only on 01.07.2023, and has been transferred again just after a year, which is in violation of the Transfer Policy. He further contends that the petitioner is a widow, and has an old ailing father to look after. Therefore, she should not have been displaced.



3. It is apparent on record that the third respondent has been transferred in place of the petitioner on account of medical exigency. The Transfer Policy also stipulates that the transfer can be made any time in case of the administrative exigency and on account of chronic disease/permanent disability, etc. Besides, the petitioner has been posted within district Faridabad; Government College, Tigaon, is at a distance of about 12 kms. only from Government College, Faridabad.

4. In view thereof, there is no merit in the petition and it stands dismissed.
