1. The present petition under Section 482 CrPC has been preferred for setting aside the order dated 03.07.2023, passed by learned Judge, Special Court, Jalandhar, whereby the bail of the petitioner was cancelled and his bail bonds and surety bonds were forfeited to the State in case FIR No.171 dated 11.10.2018 registered under Section 22 of the NDPS Act at Police Station Division No.5, Police Commissionerate Jalandhar.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in compliance to the order dated 04.09.2023 passed by this Court, the petitioner has surrendered in the Court and furnished his requisite bail bonds. He has placed on record copy of the order dated 11.09.2023, whereby the learned trial Court has admitted the petitioner on interim bail.
3. Learned State counsel has not disputed the aforesaid factum.
4. Heard.
5. Keeping in view the fact that the petitioner has already appeared in the Court and furnished his requisite bail/surety bonds consequent to the order

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dated 04.09.2023, passed by this Court, the present petition is allowed. The order dated 03.07.2023, passed by learned Judge, Special Court, Jalandhar is set aside and the interim bail granted vide order dated 04.09.2023 is hereby confirmed.
