[1] The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.51 dated 10.06.2021, under Sections 363, 366, 120-B IPC registered at Police Station Cantt. Ferozepur, District Ferozepur (Annexure P-1), on the basis of compromise/affidavit dated 20.09.2022 (Annexure P-2) executed by respondent No.2.

[2] On 08.07.2024, this Court passed the following order:

'Report from the trial Court has been received.

As per the report, accused Sahil son of Sunny alias Golu, who is petitioner No.3 in the present petition is involved in other criminal case bearing FIR No.115 dated 15.09.2022 under Sections 21, 61, 85 of the NDPS Act registered at Police Station Cantt., Ferozepur and the parties have failed to appear before the Court for recording of their statements in compliance of the order dated 18.01.2023 passed by the Coordinate Bench of this Court.

Learned counsel for the petitioners seeks short accommodation.
Adjourned to 21.08.2024.'



[3] The petitioner No.3-Sahil is having history of other criminal case under the NDPS Act.

[4] Keeping in view the history of another case against the petitioner No.3, no ground is made out for invoking jurisdiction under the provisions of Section 482 Cr.P.C.

[5] Even otherwise, there is no representation on behalf of the petitioners. On the last date of hearing i.e. 19.11.2024 also, the petitioners remained unrepresented.

[6] As such, the present petition is dismissed for want of prosecution.

[7] Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
