1. The petitioners have filed the present petition under Section 482 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 with a prayer to grant anticipatory bail to them in case FIR No.147 dated 23.07.2024, registered under Sections 316(2), 318(4), 338, 336(3), 340(2), 351 (2,3), 61(2), 238 of BNS, at Police Station City Thanesar, District Kurukshetra.
2. Learned counsel for the parties have amicably resolved their dispute. Learned counsel for the parties submit that the petitioners have already paid a sum of Rs.25 lakhs to the complainant to settle the dispute in the present case.
3. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the complainant, on instructions from his client, submits that his client has no objection in case the present petition is ordered to be allowed by this Court.
4. Learned State counsel has submitted that the petitioners have joined the investigation and are no longer required for further investigation.



4. In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the parties, the present petition is allowed and the interim order dated 16.09.2024, passed by this Court is made absolute. However, the petitioners shall join the investigation, as and when called by the Investigating Officer and shall also abide by the conditions as provided under Section 482(2) of the BNSS.
