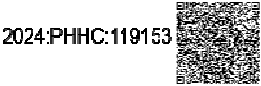

NAMIT KUMAR, J. (ORAL)

1. Present petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India praying for issuance of writ in the nature of *mandamus* directing the respondents to consider the case of the petitioner for grant of deemed date of promotion as Accounts Clerk w.e.f. 07.09.1979, Deputy Superintendent from 24.11.1995 and to the post of Circle Superintendent w.e.f. 11.04.2007 i.e. the date when the junior to the petitioner, namely, Shri Sham Lal (now retired)-respondent No.3 was promoted as Circle Superintendent and to grant him all consequential benefits. In the alternative, prayer has been made for direction to the respondents to consider and take a final decision on the petitioner's representation dated 16.02.2023 (Annexure P-2) within a stipulated period.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner at the outset confines his prayer for deciding representation dated 16.02.2023 (Annexure P-2). He submits that at this stage, petitioner would be satisfied, if the



said representation is considered and decided by passing a speaking order in a time-bound frame.

- 4. Mr. Saurabh Mohunta, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondents-State.
- 5. I have heard learned counsel for the parties and have gone through the record of the case.
- 6. Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or the claim being made by the petitioner in the present petition, respondent No.2 is directed to consider and decide the claim made by the petitioner in representation dated 16.02.2023 (Annexure P-2) in accordance with law, by passing a speaking order within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
- 7. The petition stands disposed of.
