Prayer in the present petition is for directing the respondents to release the due payment of Rs.6,18,503/- on account of the outstanding towards the work executed by the petitioner alongwith interest @ 12% per annum.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that with regard to his grievance, recently he has submitted representation dated 22.05.2024 (Annexure P-11) upon respondent-No.2-Commissioner, Municipal Corporation, Moga but no action has been taken by the respondent-department.

Notice of motion.

Ms. Akshita Chauhan, DAG, Punjab appears and accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1.



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Mr. Vikram Preet Arora, Advocate appears and accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.2 to 5-Municipal Corporation, Moga.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, however, submits that at this juncture, he would be satisfied if respondent No.2-the Commissioner, Municipal Corporation, Moga is directed to consider and decide the representation dated 22.05.2024 (Annexure P-11) in a time bound manner.

Counsel for the respondents do not oppose the prayer made by the learned counsel for the petitioner.

Accordingly, in view of the above; with the consent of the parties and without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of while directing respondent No.2 to consider and decide the representation dated 22.05.2024 (Annexure P-11) by passing a reasoned and speaking order after affording an opportunity of hearing to the respective parties within a period of three months of the receipt of certified copy of this order.

Needless to mention that upon considering the said representation, if any amount is found due and payable to the petitioner, the same shall be disbursed in favour of the petitioner within a further period of three months.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
