Learned counsel for the respondent-State submits that in case, any representation is filed by the petitioner, the same will be decided in accordance with law and appropriate order on the claim of the petitioner will be passed within a period of 06 weeks from the date of receipt of such representation and in case, it is found feasible, the relief will be extended to petitioner otherwise, due reasons for not accepting the claim of the petitioner

will be mentioned in the order so passed, which will be conveyed to the petitioner as well for his information and necessary action.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement made by learned counsel for the respondents, present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
