The petitioner has filed the present petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India read with Section 528 of B.N.S.S with a prayer to direct the respondent No.2 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and his family members and not to harass them at the behest of respondents No.5 to 12.

On advance notice, Mr. Deepinder Singh Brar, Sr. DAG, Punjab has appeared on behalf of official respondents and submits that no complaint with regard to the property in question is pending with the local police and the petitioner and his family members have not been called with regard to the property dispute till today.

4. Needless to observe that, the petitioner is at liberty to avail his

alternative remedy, if any, in accordance with law.
