HARKESH MANUJA, J.(ORAL)

1. By way of present petition filed under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, prayer has been made for initiating contempt proceedings against the respondents for willful non-compliance of the Order dated 13.03.2024 passed by this Court in CWP-5909 of 2024.

2. Learned State counsel informs that the benefit as ordered by Writ Court has been accorded to the petitioners and the necessary payment shall be released in their favour within a period of one week from today.

3. In view of the aforesaid undertaking, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the petition with liberty to seek revival, in case, the needful is not done.

4. Ordered accordingly. Rule stands discharged.

5. In addition, the petitioners shall be at liberty to raise their claim against the respondents, in case, any cause still survives by making a representation within a period of two weeks which shall be decided by the respondents within four weeks thereafter and a copy of speaking order



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passed thereupon shall be forwarded to the petitioners within another two weeks. In any eventuality, wherein the petitioner is made to file recalling/restoration application, the respondents concerned shall be liable to pay costs of Rs.50,000/- to each of the petitioners.
