1. The present Civil Revision Petition has been filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India for setting aside the order dated 12.07.2022 (Annexure P-1) passed by the Civil Judge (Jr. Divn.), Faridabad whereby the application under Order 6 Rule 17 read with Section 151 CPC has been dismissed.

2. It has been brought to the notice of this Court that the main suit itself has been dismissed in default vide order dated 10.11.2023 by the trial Court.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in view of the above, the present petition has been rendered infructuous and the same be disposed of at this stage but liberty may be granted to the petitioner to revive the petition, in case any cause of action survives.

4. In view of the above, present Civil Revision Petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous with the aforesaid liberty.
