1. Present civil revision petition has been filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India for setting aside the order dated 31.07.2023 passed by the Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Amritsar, whereby the interim maintenance has been awarded.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in view of the law laid down in “*Bhanu Kiran Vs. Rahul Khosla and others*’, *reported as 2023(4) ICC 88*, the petitioner be permitted to file an appeal under Section 29 of the Protection of Woman from Domestic Violence Act, 2005, inasmuch as, in the said judgment it has been held that against the interim maintenance order, an appeal under Section 29 of the Protection of Woman from Domestic Violence Act, 2005 is maintainable.
3. In view of the above, the present revision petition is dismissed as withdrawn, with the aforesaid liberty.
