1. This writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India *inter alia* for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing order dated 15.07.2024, Annexure P-11, passed by respondent No.2, whereby arms license has been cancelled.
2. Counsel for the petitioner submits that as the petitioner has a statutory remedy, he has filed an appeal under Section 18 of the Arms Act, 1959, before the Principal Secretary, Department of Home. He submits that the appeal is yet to be taken up for hearing.
