MANJARI NEHRU KAUL, J. (ORAL)

1. After arguing for some time, when this Court was not inclined to grant relief as prayed for, since all the pleas which were raised by the learned counsel would be a matter of trial, a prayer was made by learned counsel for the petitioner for withdrawal of the instant petition with liberty to raise all pleas during the course of trial.
2. Dismissed as withdrawn with aforesaid liberty.
3. Pending applications, if any, stand disposed of.
4. At this stage, a prayer has been made by learned counsel for the petitioner that since the petitioner is a 60 year old man, who is bedridden on account of some injury which he received in an accident, he may not be able to appear before the learned Trial Court during the course of trial and, hence, a prayer has been made for exempting his appearance before the learned Trial Court.
5. Personal appearance of the petitioner is exempted before the Trial Court. However, the exemption qua personal appearance of



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the petitioner shall be subject to the following conditions:-

- (i) That the counsel for the petitioner would appear on each and every date of hearing and will not delay/stall the proceedings in the trial Court.
- (ii) That the petitioner will not raise any dispute qua his identity as an accused and also not raise any objection, if the prosecution evidence is recorded in his absence, but in the presence of the counsel representing him.
- (iii) That no dispute will be raised by the petitioner qua the identity of the witnesses examined in his absence.
- (iv) That an undertaking shall be given by the petitioner before the trial Court that he would put in appearance as and when called upon to do so by the trial Court.
- (v) Any other condition that may be imposed by the trial Court.
