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**AMARJOT BHATTI, J.**

Petitioners Arpan Singh and Shamsheer Singh have filed anticipatory bail petition under Section 482 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 in case FIR No. 116 dated 05.07.2024 under Sections 115, 118(1), 118(2), 189, 190 of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023, registered at Police Station City Sri Muktsar Sahib, District Sri Muktsar Sahib.

2. As per the facts of case, Satwinder Singh gave his statement to police that on 02.07.2024, he alongwith Sahil and Harpreet Singh had gone out for a walk after dinner in Street No. 5, Abohar road. At about 10:30 PM, Karma Singh armed with khanda, Gurpreet Singh alias Money armed



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with sword, Arpan Singh armed with handle of spade, Jaskaran Singh armed with wooden stick, Shamsheer Singh armed with sword, Manjit Singh armed with sword and Shambhu Singh armed with kapa came towards them and gave beatings. Karma Singh inflicted khanda blow towards Sahil, as a result, his left arm above wrist was amputated. Others also gave beatings with their own respective weapons. Complainant tried to rescue Sahil. Even he was caused injuries by Shambhu Singh with his kapa. They raised hue and cry. Thereafter, all assailants ran away with their respective weapons. Both of them were admitted in Government Hospital, Sri Muktsar Sahib. Sahil was further referred to GGS Medical College, Faridkot.

3. Learned counsel for petitioners argued that present petitioners are falsely implicated. They are not attributed with fatal blow. Petitioner No. 1 is a student, whereas, petitioner No. 2 is a *Granthi* in Gurudwara, Sri Muktsar Sahib. They are ready to join investigation.

4. Bail petition is opposed by learned counsel representing State. Status report is filed, which is taken on record. Mr. Karandeep Singh Sidhu, Advocate appeared on behalf of complainant and filed his Memorandum of Appearance.

5. It is argued that present petitioners alongwith co-accused caused serious injuries to Sahil. He suffered five injuries, out of which injury No. 3 is amputation of left hand. Both petitioners are specifically named and they were armed with weapons. They are required for joining investigation as well as for recovery of weapons of offence.



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6. I have considered the arguments and have gone through the record carefully. Present petitioners are specifically named. They alongwith other co-accused as detailed in FIR attacked complainant Satwinder Singh and Sahil. Both of them received injuries, whereas, left hand of Sahil was amputated and said blow is attributed to Karma Singh. Investigation is at initial stage. Weapons of offence are yet to be recovered. Therefore, considering the aforesaid facts, I do not find a fit case for grant of anticipatory bail to petitioners – Arpan Singh and Shamsheer Singh accordingly, petition filed by them is dismissed.

7. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, stand disposed of accordingly as well.
