1. The appellants are challenging the order dated 28.08.2023 passed by the learned Judge, Special Court, Ludhiana vide which their applications seeking concession of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.31 dated 18.05.2022 under Sections 355, 323, 294, 506 of the IPC (offence

under Section 294 of the IPC deleted and under Sections 295-A, 120-B of the IPC and Sections 3 and 4 of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 were added lateron) registered at Police Station Sudhar, District Ludhiana, were dismissed.

2. On 28.11.2023, this Court had granted the concession of interim bail to the appellants and asked them to join investigation.

3. Learned counsel for the appellants submits that in compliance of order dated 28.11.2023, the appellants have joined investigation and cooperated with the investigating agency.

4. Learned State counsel, on instructions, does not dispute the factum of the appellants having joined investigation and cooperated with the investigating agency. He, on further instructions, submits that the appellants are not required for further investigation much less for their custodial interrogation.

5. In view of the above, the appeals are allowed and interim order dated 28.11.2023, is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
