

the veracity of the allegations made by the petitioner, has accepted the cancellation report. It is further contended that the contentions of the petitioner in protest petition have also not been recorded in the findings mentioned in the impugned order.

3. Per contra, learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Harjinder Singh, submits that the veracity of the allegations made by the petitioner was thoroughly examined by a senior officer of the rank of Assistant Commissioner of Police and it has been found that allegations leveled by the petitioner are false. The petitioner has already appeared before the concerned jurisdictional Magistrate and filed a protest petition and has prayed for taking of cognizance of the offences against the accused and the learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Amritsar has treated the protest petition filed by the petitioner as a private complaint and she was directed to produce her evidence on 28.05.2018. It is further contended that the petitioner has never challenged the finding of the inquiry report (Annexure P-3).

4. Having heard learned counsel for the parties and after perusing the record of the case, this Court finds no merit in the arguments advanced by learned counsel for the petitioner. The veracity of the allegations was examined by the jurisdictional police authorities and the allegations leveled against the accused were found to be false and it has been concluded in the report that the petitioner has fabricated a false story and the learned trial Court has rightly decided to treat the protest petition filed by the complainant as a private complaint on the ground that it is not a case where the evidence is beyond the reach of the Court.

5. In view of the above, no ground for interference is made out and the present petition stands dismissed being devoid of any merit.

6. However, nothing observed hereinabove shall be construed as

expression of opinion of this Court on merits of the case and the trial Court shall proceed without being prejudiced by observations of this Court.
