1. In the present writ petition, the grievance of the petitioner is that the petitioner has served more than three decades with the respondents but her services have not been regularized hence, keeping in view the decision of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in *Civil Appeal No. 6798 of 2019 titled as Prem Singh Vs. State of Uttar Pradesh and others, on 02.09.2019* as well as in *SLP (Civil) No. 6427 of 2019 titled as Ushaben Joshi vs. Union of India and others, decided on 02.08.2024*, the petitioner is entitled for the grant of regularization so that at the fag end of the career, the petitioner can avail the pensionary benefits.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the grievance raised in the present petition has already been raised by the petitioner in the representation dated 15.01.2024 (Annexure P-30) which is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied at this

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stage in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the said representation by passing an appropriate speaking order.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Arun Gupta, learned Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

5. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case the representation dated 15.01.2024 (Annexure P-30) has been received in the office of the concerned authorities and the same is still pending consideration with the authorities concerned, the same will be decided by the competent authority within a period of eight weeks from the date of the receipt of certified copy of this order by passing an appropriate speaking order and in case, after the decision any relief is to be extended to the petitioner, the same will be extended, otherwise due reasons will be mentioned in the speaking order to be passed for not accepting the claim of the petitioner for her information and necessary action.

6. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned State counsel, the present writ petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.

7. Ordered accordingly.
